

PREPARATORY WORKS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PASTEUR VIADUCTS ON THE RIGHT BANK OF PONT FLAUBERT

2nd PHASE

In order to allow for the construction of the Pasteur Viaducts, which will cross the electrified railway tracks, support structures (Berliner walls), need to be installed on both sides of the tracks. The first phase of installing these supports was carried out from 17 November to 8 December, 2023 inclusive. The second phase of the construction of these supports consists of drilling, laying concrete, felling trees, and earthworks to the south of the railway tracks.

These works, undertaken by Bouygues Travaux Publics and Pro-Fond, will be carried out from 29 January to 24 February, 2024, and can only be done during specific time periods when there is no rail traffic.

These operations may generate noise at night from Monday to Friday, between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m., and on weekends from 10 to 11 February, 17 to 18 February and 24 to 25 February 2024, and on Saturday between 4:30 p.m. and midnight.

None of these operations will cause any additional traffic disruptions on the SUD III expressway.

The works are planned as follows:

- from 29 January to 9 February: tree felling and earthworks
- from 9 February to 18 February: drilling, laying concrete, installing metal structure
- from 19 February to 25 February: installing the Berliner wall.
