



PREPARATORY WORKS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PASTEUR VIADUCTS ON THE LEFT BANK OF PONT FLAUBERT

In order to facilitate the construction of the Pasteur Viaducts, which will cross the electrified railway tracks, support structures (Berliner walls) will have to be erected on both sides of the tracks. The initial construction phase of these support structures consists of drilling, pouring concrete and carrying out earthworks to the north of the railway tracks.

These works will be carried out by Bouygues Travaux Publics and Pro-Fond between **17 November and 22 December 2023** and can only be done whilst there is no rail traffic during specific time periods.

These operations may generate noise at night from Monday to Friday, between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m., and on the weekends of 18 to 20 November and 25 to 27 November 2023, beginning on Saturday at 4:30 p.m. and until Monday at 5 a.m.

None of these works will cause any traffic disruptions on the SUD III expressway.
