FROM 4 SEPTEMBER TO 23 JANUARY 2024 ZONE 5 - SECTOR 2 - ROADWORKS QUAI DE FRANCE

Between 4 September and 23 January 2024, roadworks will be carried out to reinforce and improve the safety of the Quai de France between the Boulevard du Midi roundabout and Rue Bourbaki.

The roadworks consist of reinforcing the existing roadway structures, modernising the road surface of the traffic lanes, improving the rainwater drainage system and the traffic lights and improving bus stop safety.

Traffic restrictions will be introduced on the quays to facilitate these roadworks. Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction instead of the existing two lanes, both during the day and at night. The lane open for each direction of traffic will be modified as the roadworks progress.

Roadworks on the Boulevard du Midi roundabout will be carried out exclusively at night (from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m.) between 11 and 22 December 2023. A diversion will be set up via the South III expressway (RN 338) / Chemin du Gord / Rue de l'Ancienne Mare / Rue des Pâtis and Rue Bourbaki / then Rue Léon Malétra.

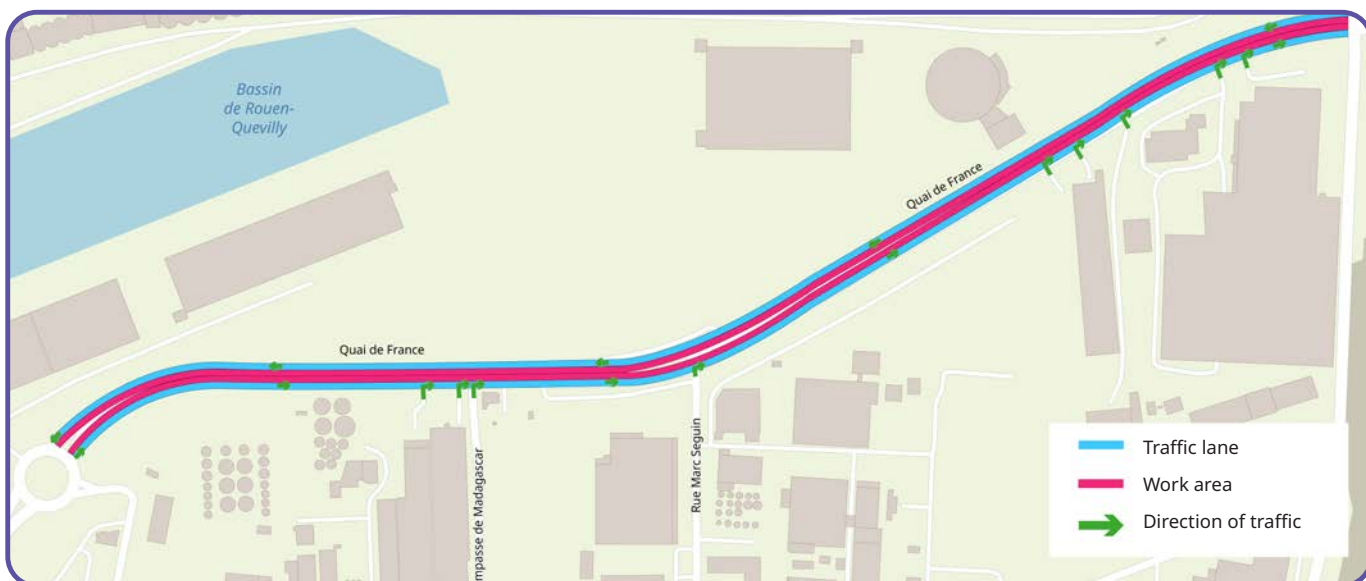
